Academic Achievement

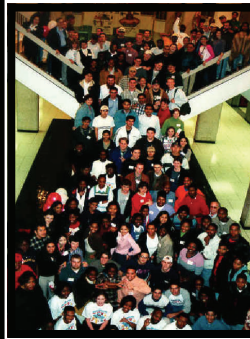
A necessary element to any successful student organization is academic excellence. Yes student organization will reward achievement by:

- Community volunteerism

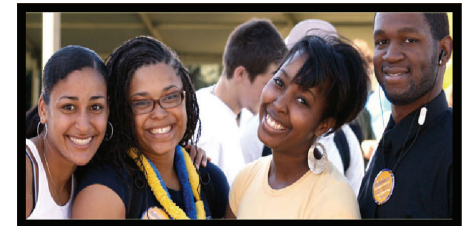
